We would like to say well done to all our Year 2 children for all their hard work during the SATs testing. They have worked extremely hard and we are very proud of them.

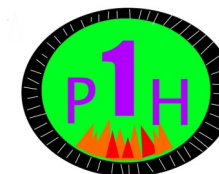


JAGUAR

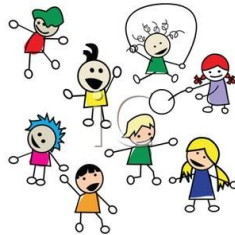


Star of the Week!

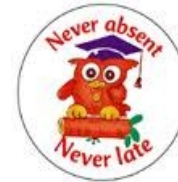
