

## **English**

In English this term we will initially recap last year's skills before moving on to learning lots of new skills. We will be tackling compound sentences and gaining an understanding about they work. Additionally we will doing a lot of work around pronouns, adjectives and prepositions.

Furthermore, we will be continuing to work on our spelling rules and handwriting to ensure our spelling is correct and our writing is legible.

We will be linking our writing to our topic, 'Magical Mystery', and will be focusing on texts such as The Worst Witch. We will also spend time learning how to successfully edit our own writing.

# **Mathematics**

In Mathematics this term we will start by learning about place value and improving our understanding about what each digit in a number represents. We will also



learn how to add and subtract using mental and written methods, as well as developing our multiplication and division skills. We will continue to use our skills to help us develop our reasoning and problem solving abilities.

We will also be extending our knowledge of shapes by learning about their properties.

Statistics will also be covered this term where we will learn how to record different data.

## **Science**

In Science this term we will be learning all about animals including humans. We will explore skeletons and different systems within the body. Furthermore, we will look at forces and how they work during which we will investigate the forces around us.

#### <u>History:</u>

This term in History we will be learning about superstition. We will be looking at various superstitions and how they have arisen. We will see how they have an impact on our lives today and discover why.

#### **Geography:**

We will be focusing on our Geography skills later in the year.

#### D&T /Art/Music:

Mr Womble will be taking the music sessions this term and will be teaching a range of musical skills to year 3.

Art will be linked to our history work around superstitions— trialing a range of techniques using a wide variety of materials including chalks, wax crayons and charcoal. DT will also link to our topic for the term and we will be making some exciting things linked to our topic.

#### MFL:

In MFL this term we will be learning some French basics including greetings and questions.

We will learn to talk about ourselves- answering and asking questions.

#### Computing :

In Computing this term we will be programming commands into a sequence and solving open ended problems.

We will also be learning how to recognize and solve bugging issues within the program.

### <u>RE:</u>

In RE this term we will be learning about Christianity and what God means to different people. This will involve various group tasks discussing how children believe God affects our lives on a daily basis and how He is perceived.

#### P.E./Games

PE will consist of working on a number of different skills this term. During the first part of the term children will carry out gymnastics, involving all skills that accompany this sport. They will then move onto Dance where they will focus on different dance skills and then create their own custom routine. Our PE lessons will take place on Tuesdays. Please ensure your child has their kit in school on this day. As part of our Social, Moral ,Spiritual and Cultural curriculum we will continue to interweave our school motto and core values into everything we do.
