Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, thank you to each and every one of you for your continued support across the first term; you should be really proud of your children as they are working exceptionally hard, maintaining their focus whilst providing an abundance of determination, since they came into year 6.

I am astutely aware that there is only a week left of the term and that our Year 6 residential takes place immediately after. With that in mind, I have attached a kit list that Laches Wood have sent to me, as a guideline, of what the children will need throughout the course of the week.

To-date, there are a number of outstanding balances, for the residential, which do need to be paid. Please be aware, due to financial constraints and to ensure that the school are not thousands of pounds out of pocket, if your balance is not paid by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> January - your child, unfortunately, **WILL NOT** be allowed to attend the residential.

The sleeping accommodation, whilst at the centre, will be dormitories (brand new). In the dormitories your child will be need to provide a duvet cover and 2 pillowcases; sheets are provided.

We want the children to enjoy their stay, and to achieve this all we ask is for them to work alongside us and the centre staff, be on time, and help their group with duties morning and evening to maintain a clean and tidy centre.

The activities, over the course, will at times be exciting and hopefully new to your child. They will be led by the Centre teachers and instructors, who are experienced and qualified and well used to all levels of ability; they should come prepared to try everything.

There is on site a tuck-shop where they will be able to buy sweets, drinks and souvenirs each evening – a little bit of spending money is allowed but again, not compulsory as they are allowed to bring a few treats with them which they can eat each evening.

There are no facilities to telephone home except in an emergency or some other pressing need where they may use the office telephone. Additionally, Children are asked NOT to bring mobile phones to the centre or any other electronic devices; these will be removed and locked away.

Finally, we suggest your child bring a number of changes of clothes that they will feel comfortable and warm in, and some that you don't mind getting dirty or wet.

They are only away for a maximum of 4 nights. Some children bring far too much luggage, and bags are sometimes too heavy for the coach driver to load safely. Too many large cases can also mean that the luggage for a group will not all fit on the mini-bus.
