

Science, STEM week

During the week of the 12th March, Perry Hall will be celebrating Science and Technology Week throughout the school. Each class will be working to create a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) project.



To celebrate this exciting week and after the success of last year's event, we are holding our own STEM fair again! We are inviting children to create their own project at home which demonstrates their understanding of 'Our Universe'. For example, children could create a map of the stars in the night sky, a model of the solar system, an experiment showing how craters are made on the moon, a model of the International Space Station... the possibilities are endless! We would be very grateful if you could support your children with their project, discussing the scientific theory behind it.

If children wish to enter, they need to bring their project, along with an explanation of the science behind their work, to class on **Monday 12th March** along with a **£1 entry fee** (all money raised will be used to fund Science activities and resources throughout the year).

One winner will be chosen from each class and will receive a certificate. These winners will be entered into our STEM fair where our governors and members of the MAT team will be invited to select a winner from each Key Stage on **Thursday 15th March**. If your child's project is entered into our STEM fair, family members will be invited to the fair to celebrate your child's entry.
