

English

In English this term we are going to be looking at books written by the famous children's author, Julia Donaldson, including The Scarecrows Wedding and Paper Dolls . Through these books we will be producing writing in various genres such as character descriptions, diary entries, letters, an extra chapter and a book review.

Following this we will then look at different types of writing based on the book The Day the Crayons Quit, which will include newspaper reports, letters, diary entries, descriptive writing, reports and instructions.

Year 2 will also be looking to extend our writing through our History topic of Florence Nightingale.

Guided reading will take place four times a week and will be based on reading skills such as comprehension, retrieval and inference.

Ten spellings will be given out weekly, five following a taught spelling pattern and five from the Year 2 common exception word list.

We will be focusing on teaching and applying cursive handwriting.

Mathematics

We will look at number and place value including reading and writing numbers and comparing and ordering 2 and 3-digit numbers. Addition and subtraction facts up to 20 and solving problems using these operations, mentally and written, will also be covered. We will study the properties of 2d shapes including pentagons, hexagons, and octagons and look at symmetry. Position, direction and movement will be learnt as well as interpreting and constructing tally charts and block graphs from which we will ask questions about them. We will be recapping the 2 5 10 times table's ensuring children know these

We will be recapping the 2, 5, 10 times table's ensuring children know these well and introducing the 3s. Please support your child in learning these.

Science

Science is about Changing Materials including exploring the characteristics of them; natural and man-made materials; changing the shapes of materials; heating and cooling and undertaking scientific investigations. In the second half of the term, areas covered will include forces and magnets.

History:

Florence Nightingale is our topic for the first half of the term. We will learn about why she is such a significant person in British history and the comparison between nursing in the 19th century and now.

<u>Geography:</u>

In Geography, we will be learning about weather through the seasons, and location and characteristics of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. Wolverhampton (a familiar location) will also be studied.

D&T /Art:

In Art, we will be making art using natural materials by looking at the work of Andy Goldsworthy.

In D.T. we will designing and creating puppets.

Computing :

In Computing, we will be using Pivot Animator to make our own digital figure move. We will use a storyboard to design a series of movements we want the figure to make before animating this on an ipad. E-safety will also form an important part of this subject.

RE:

RE is centred around Islam and the areas covered are what is a leader; a mosque and other religious places of worship in our community; sacred books and festivals and what matters to Muslims and ourselves.

P.E./Games

Football and Dance will be areas in our PE curriculum in the first half of the term, and netball and gymnastics in the second half.

PSHE:

During the whole term, PHSE will include New Beginnings, Feelings, Getting on and Falling Out and Bullying. As part of our Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural curriculum we will continue to interweave our school motto and core values into everything we do. Motto:
