

<u>English</u>

In English this term we will initially recap last year's skills before moving on to learning new ones. We will be tackling compound sentences and gaining an understanding about how they work. Additionally we will be writing using pronouns, adjectives and prepositions.

We will continue to work on our spelling rules and handwriting to ensure our spelling is correct and our writing is legible.

This half term, our writing will be linked to our topic, 'Stone Age to the Iron Age', and will be focusing on texts such as Stone Age Boy. We will also spend time learning how to successfully edit our own writing.

Mathematics

In Mathematics this term we will start by learning about place value and improving our understanding about what each digit in a number represents. We will also



learn how to add and subtract using mental and written methods, as well as developing our multiplication and division skills. We will continue to use these skills to help us develop our reasoning and problem solving abilities.

We will also be extending our knowledge of shapes and their properties.

Statistics will also be covered this term, where we will learn methods of how to record different data.

<u>Science</u>

In Science this term we will be learning all about *Rocks and Soils*. We will explore different types of rock such as sedimentary, metamorphic and igneous. We will investigate the different properties and uses of rocks such as pumice, chalk and slate.

<u>History:</u>

In History we will focus on the Romans' impact on British settlements, and how they influenced Britain. We will look at the contributions the Romans brought to Britain and the impact today.

Geography:

This term we will be learning about geographical regions in the UK and identifying human and physical characteristics. We will also be locating countries around the world, focusing on Europe.

D&T /Art/Music:

Art will be linked to our history work around Stone Age to Iron Age– where we will be trialing a range of techniques using a wide variety of materials including sand, paint and clay. DT will also link to our topic for the term where we will develop our skills of planning, designing, making and evaluating.

MFL:

During our MFL lessons we will be learning some French basics including greetings and questions. We will learn to talk about ourselves- answering and asking questions.

<u>Computing :</u>

In Computing this term we will be programming commands into a sequence and solving open ended problems.

We will also be learning how to recognise and solve bugging issues within the program.

<u>RE:</u>

In RE we will be learning about Christianity and what God means to different people. This will involve various group tasks discussing how children believe God affects people's lives on a daily basis and how He is perceived.

P.E./Games

During the first part of the term children will carry out gymnastics, involving all skills that accompany this sport. They will then move onto Dance where they will create their own custom routine. Our PE lessons will take place on Tuesdays. Please ensure your child has their kit in school on this day.
