Year 2 trip to Bantock House & Museum

As you will already be aware, we are going to study the work of British artist, Andy Goldsworthy who creates sculptures and artwork using natural materials. We are also going to be doing creative writing about nature in English. To support this work, we will be taking the children to Bantock House and Museum in Wolverhampton to participate in an arts and nature workshop and explore the historic house and grounds.

We will be going on Thursday 8th November 2018 leaving at approximately 9.30am and returning for the end of the school day.

As we will be out of school on the above day, a packed lunch with a plastic bottle for a drink is required. The school will provide a packed lunch/drink for children who are entitled to a free school meal (see note below).

As we will be exploring the garden and grounds of Bantock House, a waterproof coat and appropriate outdoor footwear will be needed.

The cost of the trip will be £8.50 per child and this will cover the cost of the workshop and entry to the house and grounds, as well as a coach to and from Bantock House and Museum.
