Dear Parent/Carer,

On Friday 23rd November we will be holding a **Wear Your Stripes Day** to raise the awareness of road safety. We are asking children to dress in fun, bright, stripy clothes in support of this day!



This is a fantastic dress-down day where children can dress like Brake's mascot Zak the Zebra (Brake is a road safety charity). They can opt for traditional black and white stripes, accessorise with colourful striped garments or even make their own zebra mask!

A child is hurt or killed every 33 minutes on UK roads. Please supervise your child closely on roads and continue to teach road safety as we hope you already do. In particular, always:

- cross roads safely with your child, using it to teach the Green Cross Code
- ensure your child holds an adult's hand around roads (age appropriate)
- in cars, ensure your child is buckled up in a child restraint suitable for their size and weight
- if you drive, go 20mph or below around homes, schools and shops, with respect for other people's children.
