

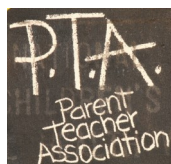

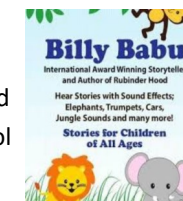


**A Place to Grow**

### Storyteller

At Perry Hall, we have been lucky enough to welcome Billy Babu, an internationally renowned storyteller and author. Billy has performed two storytelling sessions this week, and he will be returning to school on Monday 11th February. Both children and staff have thoroughly enjoyed the experience.



This week, Mr Crilly from Severn Trent came to visit Key Stage 2

to tell them all about the importance of saving water. We looked at how some people waste water at the moment, and then how we could all work together to reduce the amount of water that we use each day.

Year 5 then took part in an interactive workshop that investigated how water currently gets from our rivers and reservoirs, to our taps at home! They had a fantastic time measuring and recording water wastage, and then produced some very persuasive posters that will help to remind others how they can save water too.



A selection of Year 5 children have been taking part in a peer support programme which started this week, which is being led by Headstart, Wolverhampton. They are learning an abundance of new life-skills, such as: communication and team work and conflict resolution skills. Once the programme has been completed, the children will be able to take on roles to support other children who might be feeling lonely, having difficulties with peer relationships, or just providing ideas of fun games and activities to play on the playground.
