Update on Colman Avenue road markings

As many parents will have seen, there has been amendments to the road markings outside of school on Colman Ave, Haden Cresent, Whittingham Grove, Perry Hall Road, and Lawrence Avenue. The new parking restrictions which will be enforced imminently will prevent motorists parking on double yellow lines or the pavement adjacent to them at any time and prevent parking on single yellow lines or the pavement adjacent to them at restricted times of the day. The restrictions include stopping, parking, loading and unloading on single yellow lines and the pavement adjacent to them during 08:30am to 09:30am Monday to Friday, 2:30pm to 4:30pm Monday to Thursday and 12:45 to 2:30pm Friday. Restrictions to parking on double yellow lines is any time of the day.

We have been advised by Wolverhampton City Council that they will be enforcing these restrictions through means of Fixed Penalty Notices.
