The school will aim to:

- provide a balanced curriculum and meet the needs of each child
- keep parents/carers informed about school activities
- inform parents/carers of any serious concerns affecting their child's work or behaviour
- inform parents/carers about their child's progress at termly meetings and provide a written report annually
- encourage mutual respect between pupils and adults
- provide appropriate home activities to support learning
- educate children regarding their own well-being, safety and the dangers found online

The family will aim to:

 ensure their child attends regularly and is brought into and collected from school on time-

- inform the school of any concerns or problems that might affect their child
- support the school's behaviour policy
- support home learning activities and make sure any materials that are borrowed from school are returned
- monitor their child's use of the internet and social networking sites, ensuring their child adhere to the age restrictions and advice given on E- Safety.
- attend Parent Consultations and Structured Meetings to discuss their child's progress
- ensure their child is dressed appropriately for school, adhering to the dress code, including the correct shoes, PE kits and jewellery
- send their child into school every day possible to reduce the gaps in learning due to absences
- encourage mutual respect between pupils and all staff by modelling positive behaviours at all times
- build positive working relationships with their child's class teacher and other adults in their child's class

Parent/Visitor Conduct On Site

Parents / visitors are expected to treat all staff and children in a respectful way when on out school site. Any threatening, abusive or violent behaviour against any staff member or child is taken extremely seriously. Examples of such behaviour are below:

- raised voices
- shouting at staff
- swearing
- o intimidating staff
- rallying other parents to become involved in intimidating behaviour
- publically voicing unsubstantiated claims about staff, children or the Academy.
- using racist or sexist terms
- o using violence
- o taking alcohol or drugs on the premises
- willful damage to school property
- theft
- o threats or threatening behaviour
- altercations (verbal or physical towards other parents whilst on the school site)

This list is not an exhaustive list but seeks to provide illustrations of such behaviour that is not acceptable in our school.

Anyone behaving in this way will be asked to leave the premises and the police will be called if verbal or physical harassment occurs. If necessary, action will be taken to ban anyone behaving in such a way from the school grounds.
