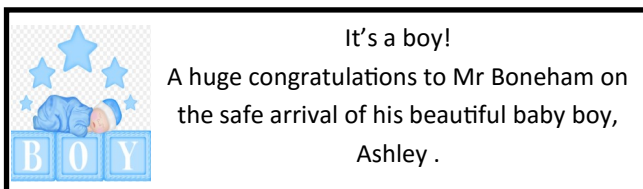


Reminder—school will be closed to pupils on 12th December 2019.
