This week marked 'National Nursery Rhyme Week' which was celebrated across our Early Years. Children from **Twos, Nursery and Reception** have enjoyed a week of singing traditional nursery rhymes and learning some new ones too. The children have put their voices to the test, rehearsing endless rhymes and joining in with the actions. The continuous provision across Early Years has enabled our children to engage in a variety of creative Nursery Rhymes related to activities including painting pictures of their favourite characters, such as Icy Wincy Spider, role play through rhymes, such as Five Little Ducks, and designing and making some Dingle Dangle Scarecrows. Twos and Reception invited parents in to join in with some nursery rhymes and crafts. Nursery will be having their Stay and Play session next Monday. Nursery rhymes are key to the development of children's language. They support children in identifying rhyme, sounds and syllables—developing skills for early reading. We hope you and your child/ren continue to enjoy more rhyming at home!

During November, pupils from Year 5 and Year 6 have been taking part in the Wolverhampton Game for Reading.

Since September, the six pupils chosen have read six book (some more than once) and have been testing their knowledge of the books as well as other authors. Early in November, the children won their first heat, which meant they progressed to the semi finals. At the semi finals, they found themselves competing against Woodthorne Primary School (another school in our MAT and last year's winner), and they won. On Wednesday 20th November, they competed in the finals of the Game for Reading and secured **second place**—an amazing achievement!
