### Why Do Birds Matter?

We often think that birds are just something pretty to look at. However, they actually serve many vital uses in the environment.

#### Did you know that birds...

- contribute to the diversity of plant life through pollination and seed dispersal;
- control insect outbreaks and create important nesting areas for other species;
- help rid the world of disease through scavenger "clean-up" services, like carrion crows and magpies.

Birds provide important economic benefits, and serve as important indicators for scientists about the state of the environment.

## Gentle reminders ...

### Uniform

If for any reason your child is not wearing the correct uniform, please inform the class teacher of the reason why.

To help prevent accidents, please ensure that your children do not wear shoes that have high or deep heels, or that are open backed. As far as possible, shoes should be flat bottomed to help to ensure your child's safety around school. Earrings should be restricted to one per ear and should be studs only. All earrings must be removed for PE lessons.

We would like to thank those parents who have ensured that their children have the correct PE kit for lessons. However, it has once again come to our attention that not all children are regularly bringing in their PE kit or in some cases not wearing the correct kit. It is very important that your child is in the correct kit and footwear for their lesson. If your child forgets their kit or is not in the correct kit, then they will be provided with spare kit to wear for their PE lesson and a letter will be sent home to inform you.

### Important end of school day reminder

Please note, once children have been released to their parents/ carers at the end of the day, the parent/ carer is responsible for their child. The members of staff at the gate / on the playground are there to answer any questions or queries parents/carers may have, not to monitor children. Please ensure you keep your children with you at all times and not let them run too far ahead, behind the cars or through the forest school area.

### Can we also remind parents...

- Please do not walk/carry your dog onto the school premises. **Dogs/puppies are not allowed on site.**
- School has a **No Smoking Policy**, so please do not smoke on the school grounds. This includes electronic cigarettes and vapes
- Due to health and safety reasons, your children are **not allowed to leave their bikes or scooters on the premises during the day.**
- If you are bringing a **bike or scooter** at the end of the day, for them to ride home, **please ensure that they are carried at all times until you leave the school premises.** If you or your child is found riding their bike/scooter on the school grounds you will be asked to stop and walk alongside it.
- **No balls, including footballs, are allowed from home.**
- **No toys, games or collector's cards are allowed in school** as they cause a lot of upset and anger when they go missing or are broken.
- As school will be providing all stationary that will be required to be used within school, this year **no pencil cases containing extra stationary will be allowed in school.**
