- To encourage communication and language through story telling and circle time



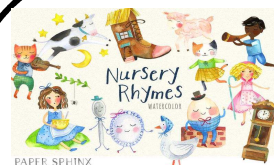
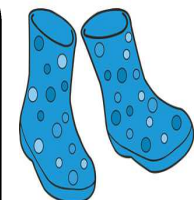
Specific Areas:

- We will be planting seeds and watching them grow

Outdoor Provision:

As we are learning all about our outside environment, we will be doing lots of activities with our friends in our outdoor provision.

To ensure your child has every opportunity to explore our outdoor area, please ensure they have labelled suitable outdoor shoes and clothing in the Twos provision.



On Mondays, we will share a 'Nursery Rhyme' for the week and a story for the half term. Your child will take part in circle time activities at the beginning of each session Monday-Friday, this will be followed by Continuous Provision. Children will also have time with their Key Person to take part in individual activities.

Continuous Provision: When children are displaying deep levels of involvement, there is increased brain activity and learning takes place.

At Terrific For Twos, we are committed to ensuring that children have maximum opportunities to learn. We will ensure that the environment your children play in is inviting and stimulating. Staff will provide opportunities for children to develop skills through various activities. This will include our staff working directly with the children and playing alongside them. Through child initiated play we will be able support your child's learning, making it fun and creative.
