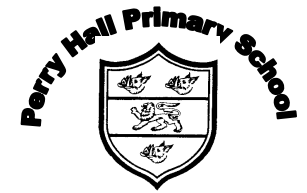

Self-isolate with cough or fever



Wash hands regularly
