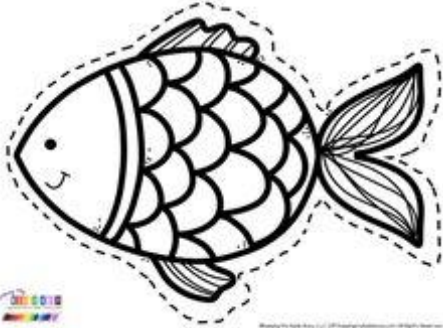

CREATE A RAINBOW.



You will need:

- Kitchen roll/paper towel
- Felt-tip pens
- Two small bowls of water
- Paperclip
- Thread

1. Cut the kitchen roll into the shape of a rainbow.
2. At each end, use the felt-tip pens to colour a rainbow about 2cm up from the bottom. Remember the order of the colours: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, violet.
3. Attach the paperclip to the top of the rainbow and tie a piece of thread to it. This will allow you to hold your rainbow.
4. Add water to the two bowls.
5. Hold the rainbow with both ends slightly submerged into each bowl of water and watch your rainbow grow.

Draw two large fish, then use buttons/coins/sequins as scales.

Can you share the scales between the two fish?

How many do they have each?

Use different amounts of objects each time.

Research using the internet or books about different types of sea creatures.

Draw or paint your favourite sea creature and write some facts about it.

What colour is your sea creature?

How do fish breath under water?

What do fish eat?
