Continuing to remain mindful of pupil and staff safety and wellbeing, Perry Hall MAT has made the decision that following an (in person) secondary school transition visit, pupils who are currently attending school are not to return to their Perry Hall bubble for 7 days to avoid any risk of cross contamination between schools and bubble groups. We thank you in advance for your understanding and support with this decision.

Wolverhampton secondary schools are currently arranging transition activities/projects, including the use of the text 'Wonder', to support children's continued home learning. We are awaiting information from schools outside of Wolverhampton but have been advised that these secondary schools will be contacting you directly to inform you of their plans.

As you know, we are always extremely keen to celebrate our Year 6 pupils' primary school journeys, achievements and memories. We are extremely saddened that given the current restrictions we are all adhering to, we are unable to lead our usual events and celebrations. We will, however, be marking the end of the year by distributing a keepsake containing well wishes from staff and also with the yearbooks for those who have ordered one. For those that have ordered a year book, you will be pleased to know that these have now been sent to print. We will make further contact with you once these have been delivered to organise a safe handover.
