
Polite Parking Notice

An update on what KS2 have been getting up to...

Year 3

This week Year 3 have enjoyed echo reading an extract from The Tin Forest. To start with it was bit tricky but the children grasped the concept and were reading in unison by the end of the week. Some children even managed to recite the extract from memory! We also studied the main character in the story and wrote thought bubbles - showing empathy towards the character. During the afternoon, children produced water colour paintings and designed the characters "dream forest" using natural resources collected from the school grounds.

Year 4

Year 4 are loving working on The Tin Forest and have created a number of fantastic pieces of work along the way in English and Art. The children have thoroughly enjoyed taking part in echo reading tasks whilst being able to understand new words and meanings. Being able to infer upon the characters feelings has proved challenging but with much resilience and hard work they have been able to do so whilst supporting their fantastic answers.



Year 5

In Year 5 this week, we have enjoyed reading The Tin Forest and exploring how the forest changes throughout the story. We made some origami flowers by following instructions and learned how to emboss string with tin foil to create a shiny effect! Aveigh said, "The origami cats are really cute and I have made loads since!" We really enjoyed describing the forest, especially thinking about what we would hear and smell if we were there, and we earned silver cards by performing fantastic role play between the Old Man and the Tiger, following our 'Go for it!' Perry Hall core value. Henley said, "I loved the story of the Tin Forest and how the forest changed and I have really enjoyed doing the art work!"

Year 6

Wow – what a fabulous week we have had, working and learning from The Tin Forest. At the beginning of the week, Year 6 were investigators and looked at images from the text to infer what the story was about and then wrote their own predictions!

Throughout the week Year 6 have completed some lovely pieces of writing, ensuring they have been imaginative and descriptive about the forest! Year 6 completed some brilliant pieces of artwork using a variety of different mediums, demonstrating their eloquence and attention to detail. 
A Place to Grow

What have EYFS been up to this week?

While We Can't Hug.

As we welcome the children to Early Years, we have been sharing the story *While We Can't Hug*. The characters in the story are Hedgehog and Tortoise who are best friends that are not allowed to hug each other at the moment due to social distancing.



The children have been discussing different ways to give affection to their friends, teachers and loved ones. Ask your child how they could show affection without touching each other.

The children have continued to settle in wonderfully—we are so proud of them!

News from KS1...

As part of the school's (and MAT's) Reading and Writing Recovery, all year groups have been focusing on the book 'The Tin Forest', both in English and during the afternoon Foundation tasks.

In Year One, the children have been focusing on developing their emotional literacy, by understanding how their feelings affect their actions and how they make their own choices, and how difficult always making the right choice can be. They have then looked at how making the right choices make us feel good. As part of their 'The Tin Forest', and for their class display of this work, the children have made flowers, trees, birds and animals, using different medium (crayons, paints, chalk, tissue paper...).

Year Two have been focusing on Prediction and Inference, developing the children's understanding of what these skills are and how to apply them. They have followed this by writing their ideas in sentences and making exciting language choices, adding adjectives to help the reader 'see' the images better. In Maths the focus has been on place value, with the children being introduced to varied fluency. In Topic, a lot of fun has been had making origami cats; sketching and drawing trees, using their hands, and sketching flowers using pencils, crayons and pastels, in the style of Georgia O'Keefe and making collages in the shape of birds.
