Dear parents/carers

As we begin our half term break, we wanted to take this opportunity to thank you for your cooperation and support with our quest to ensure the safety and well-being of our pupils, their families and our staff during these exceptionally challenging times.

A polite reminder- **if your child displays any symptoms of Coronavirus or tests positive for Coronavirus, you must inform the school office as soon as possible.** We need to be informed under any circumstance: whether your child has been in school, absent for any reason or if your child/family have been isolating and your child starts displaying symptoms or tests positive while off. **Your child, together with the whole household and support bubble, should remain off school and isolate until a negative test result is received for your child or for the full isolation period if your child is to test positive.**

Please also ensure that the school is also informed immediately if a member of your household or support bubble displays any symptoms of Coronavirus or tests positive for Coronavirus. If this is the case, your child should not be in school and should isolate (along with the rest of the household and support bubble) until a negative test result is received or for the full isolation period if the household/support bubble member is to test positive.
