When at school we go on lots of nature walks to explore the outdoor environment and we have seen lots of natural objects such as twigs, leaves and conkers.
With your grown up see what you can find.

Talk to your grown up about different types objects you have found?
What do they feel like?
What colours can you see?
What shapes can you see?
How many did you find?

As this week is harvest week, we have been painting with different vegetables.
We have used broccoli at school, you can try this at home and maybe try potato printing?



You can use pasta and rice to make a harvest picture and you can add the objects you found on your nature walk if you like!



We sing lots of different nursery rhymes in Twos. Sing some of your favourites with your grown up. See some examples below:

Incy Wincy spider
Humpty Dumpty
Ba ba black sheep
Twinkle twinkle little star



Have a go at drawing some of these objects with your grown up.



Have a go at this matching numbers game:
Can you find a conker with a number on and place it into the correct number cake case.



Make a lincy wincy of your own from junk or from vegetables:

i.e. - toilet rolls, cardboard tubes, empty yoghurt pots, small potatoes cut in half



Have a go at painting with the conkers, all you need are some conkers, paint and a tray. You can also use paper too.

See what patterns and shapes you can create.



Explore scooping and transporting different kinds of cereal with your diggers and trucks.



Have a go at creating fantastic marks as you move the car around with a felt pen/crayon attached to it.

All you need is a car, felt pen, paper and sticky tape.



Practice your letter formation. Practise examples can be found on the home learning page on the school website.

Practise counting from 1 – 5. Ask your grown up to write the numbers 1-5 on paper so that you can see them too.

See if you can go up to the number 10!

Have a go at tracing your name. Ask your grown up to write out your name so that you can trace around it.
