Create your own mud picture!

Leaf Sorting

Can you sort them into their different Autumn colours - red, yellow, green, brown, orange?



- I. Collect a bowlful of mud from the garden. Add water if needed.
- Check the mud for living creatures and return them to the garden.
- 3. Divide the mud into how many containers you like decide what colour each batch of mud is going to be.
- 4. Sprinkle in your powdered paint or choice of colouring.
- 5. Add a small amount of washing up liquid.
- 6. Mix together the mud, colouring and washing up liquid.
- 7. The paint is then ready to use where ever you choose outside. It may just be on paper or on the trees, pavement, fence etc.
