


Contact Details

Important Reminders and Updates...

In light of us entering the second national lockdown, with Covid-19 cases on the rise, we would like to remind all adults who enter the school site that a face covering must be worn unless you are exempt. This is to protect all other parents and adults and to reassure our community; we thank all adults who have already shown your support by wearing a face covering when dropping off and collecting children.

Additionally, please continue to keep 2m distance from all other families when dropping off and collecting your child from school – as we are all aware, the mixing of households, indoor and outdoor, is currently not allowed.

The one way system around school continues to be in place and is proving to be effective – thank you to those families that are adhering to this. Please could all EYFS (Reception, Nursery and Twos) parents ensure that they do not take the shortcut route when dropping off children in a morning and enter the car park through the exit – please walk around the one way system that is in place.

Wherever possible, to reduce the number of people on site at any one time, please could only one person come to drop off and collect children.
