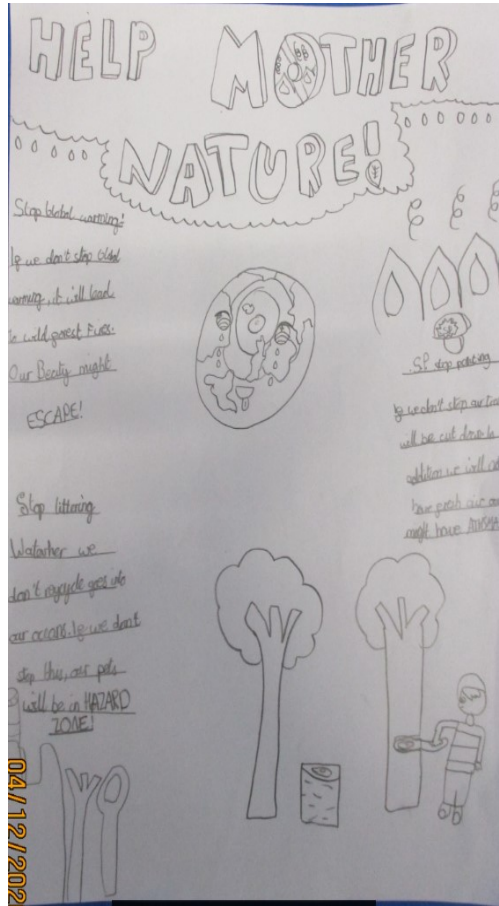

Geography Awareness Week...

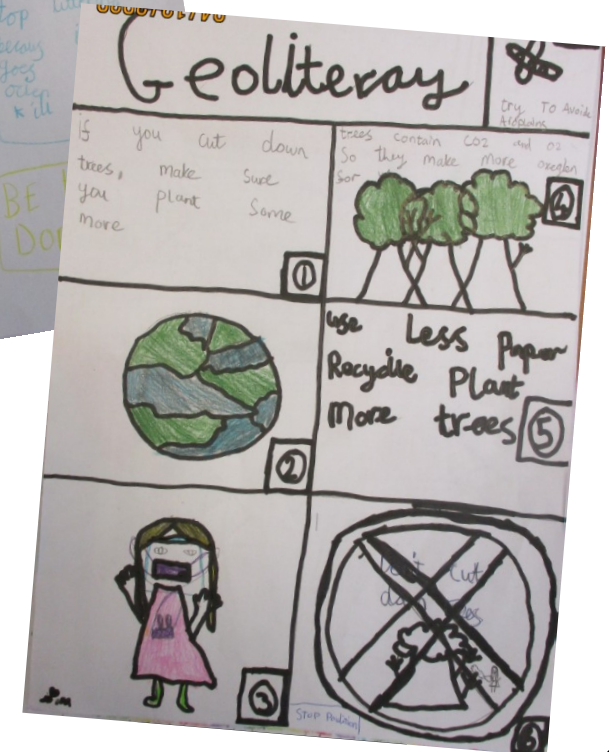
The week of beginning 16th November was **Geography Awareness Week**. This is an annual event to heighten our awareness of our effect upon our planet, Earth. Also known as Geo-literacy (National Geographic's own term), the aim is for everyone to understand how the Earth works and how we in one part of the world affect other parts, for example Pollution in England help cause the fires in Australia and the U.S.



Other classes focused on the work of environmentalist—for example, Andy Goldsworthy, British sculptor and photographer. They looked at how he uses natural materials (fallen leaves and tree branches, and stones). The children then produced their own sculptures!



All year groups had the opportunity to access the WAQI (World Air Quality Index), which shows the quality of the air around the world, and is refreshed every 2—3 hours. While the U.K. is usually classified as Good, it is interesting to hover over other cities and towns to see the quality of their air. (waqi.info)!
