Year 4 Remote Learning

Dear parents/carers,

As your child has not taken part in online, live learning sessions before, your child's online learning timetable will not fully start until Wednesday 6th January.

Monday 4th January

- During this morning, a member of the Year 4 team will be contacting you and your child by phone. Prior to this call, please ensure that you have trialled logging onto your child's Teams account and can access the Year 4 Home Learning Pages. Children will need to have access to a device that they can use to log on to Teams. We appreciate that not all pupils have this access and if this is the case, please ensure you have informed school of this by using your year group email address. During this phone conversation, the Year 4 member of staff will talk you through how to use Teams and ensure that you can access and utilise the main functions.
- Prior to this phone call, you must have returned the home school agreement statement to your child's year group email account (sent today- 4th January). Please note, by agreeing to the statements outlined in the home school agreement, you are agreeing to your child being visible to and heard by their year group peers and school staff during live sessions.
- A home learning timetable including video links and activities will be uploaded to the Files section of Teams for your child to access and complete throughout today.

Tuesday 5th January

- At 1.30pm, children (who can access Teams) will be required to join their classmates for a short 'test' session to ensure that everything is up and running. The expectations and home school agreement will be discussed with your child during this session followed by a story.



From Wednesday 6th January

The following time table, outlining live teaching sessions, will come into effect:

**When accessing live sessions, please ensure that the Home School Agreement is being followed.*

In addition to the live teaching session timetable above, a daily timetable will be uploaded to the Files section of Teams which will outline additional tasks that your child will need to complete.

If your child needs any assistance when tackling tasks, then please email the year group email address (ph.y4homelearning@perryhallmat.co.uk) to request support from a member of staff, who will then video call you and your child, via Teams, as soon as they can.

Staff will available daily between 8.30am and 3.30pm.

Thank you for your ongoing support and we look forward to continuing to support your child in their learning at home.
