### Covid Testing– reminders.

If your child is displaying coronavirus symptoms, please note that they need to take a **full PCR test and not a lateral flow home test kit**. The evidence that school needs in order for a child to return to school is a **negative result from a PCR test** which needs to be **emailed into the school** email address.
