Please note, if you made payment for the **Spring Term this has already been transferred over to the Summer Term**. If your child has **free school meals or is under 5 on 19.04.2021**, you are entitled to **free milk** and this will be ordered automatically by the school office.



If you are not sure whether you are entitled to free school meals and free milk please speak to the office.

- **06.05.21**– Voting Day– **school closed** to all children due to it being a polling station.



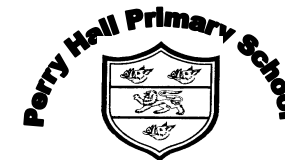
