A Place to Grow

This grid outlines the knowledge and skills that Two's children will gain throughout this term's topic.

As readers we will:

- Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories.
- Develop play around favorite stories using props.
- Look at words in our environment and talk about them with our grown ups.



As mathematicians we will:

- Compare sizes, weights using language such as bigger/little/smaller.
- Notice patterns and arrange items in patterns.
- Play freely with blocks and boxes both indoors and outdoors.



As writers we will:

- Use sensory play to mark make with our fingers.
- Use our outdoor environment such as sticks, twigs, stones etc to create marks.
- Using our stories and rhymes we will create simple story maps.



As investigators we will:

- We will explore natural materials indoor and outdoor.
- Watch our 'garden grow' through our growing project.
- Explore the effects of the weather on our outdoor environment.
- Create nature spots for us to explore our wildlife.



As individuals we will:

- Increase in confidence and explore the environment independently.
 - Develop those special friendships
- Use story time and props to explore different emotions.
- Begin to talk about my emotions with my grown ups.

As movers we will:

- Move and dance to music.
- Use our nursery rhymes and stories to create different movements (stamping, jumping, turning, crawling, tip toe etc)
- Play confidently on our outdoor equipment.
