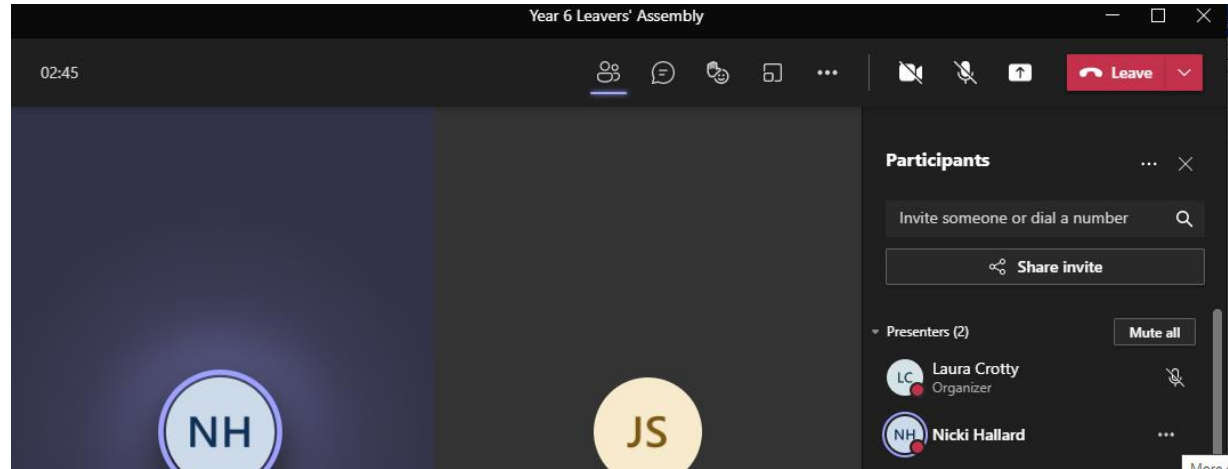
Year 6 Leaver's Celebration for parents/carers- Microsoft Teams- Monday 19th July- 1.15pm

As you are aware, on Monday 19th July at 1.15pm, we will be streaming the Year 6 Leaver's Assembly. To be able to access this, you will need to log into your child's Teams account. We suggest you log on in plenty of time in case you incur any technical issues. We are aware that many children have multiple adults that may want to watch the performance, however, only one person will be able to log in to your child's Teams account at any one time, therefore, you will all need to be in front of the same device.

Ahead of your child's performance, please ensure that you have checked that you are able to access their Teams account. If you are having problems accessing Teams, please let the Year 6 staff know as soon as possible by emailing ph.y6homelearning@perryhallmat.co.uk or contacting the school office before the close of school this afternoon (Friday).

Once you are logged in, on the day, please ensure that you keep your camera turned off and that you keep yourselves on mute throughout the performance: this will keep interruptions to a minimum and will avoid any background distractions. Please see the photo below of the strike through the camera and microphone- this can be achieved by simply pressing the icons. If interruptions from parents/carers do occur, then you will be removed from the call. Thank you for your understanding.

To ensure that you are able to watch the entire production without interruption, it is also advised that you 'pin' the screen being presented as shown below. This is done by selecting the three dots next to 'Nikki Hallard' and select 'pin'. Mrs Hallard will be the member of staff sharing the video through her laptop.



Again, if for any reason you do not wish for your child to be involved in this performance which will be streamed on Teams to parents/carers, then please inform the main school office by the end of the school day today (16.07.21).



By logging onto your child’s Teams account, in line with the agreement you have already signed for remote learning, you are agreeing to not take any photographs or recordings of the assembly as you do not have the permission of the other children’s parents/carers.

We also wanted to take this opportunity to say how proud we are of the effort and enthusiasm that the children have demonstrated over the past few days. We have not had the time we had planned to put together a full Perry Hall production this year, due to Covid restrictions and the recent bubble closure. The Year 6’s have been a credit to you all in the way that they have pulled together in order to share their favourite memories of their Perry Hall journey and to get to enjoy celebrating their end of primary school journey together.

Year 6 Leaver’s Fest for pupils- Perry Hall Primary School Playground- Monday 19th July- 4.30-6pm

As explained on previous letters, we are holding ‘Leavers Fest’ after school on the 19th July. The dress code for this event is ‘festival attire’.

This will be a fun evening with your children’s friends and with staff throughout the school, including an inflatable assault course (**please ensure your child is wearing or has socks as they will need these to go on the course**), games, music, a pizza buffet, and other tasty treats including desserts, sweets and mocktails. Although cameras and mobile phones will not be allowed on the evening, there will be photo opportunities through the use of a teacher lead photo area, where your child will have the opportunity to have photos taken with their friends and bring 3 photographs home with them (dependent on whether you have sent in permission for them to do so).

Your child will need to enter school via the main school gate at 4.30pm where they will then either go on to the playground, or in to the main hall if the weather does not allow for outdoor celebrations. Your child will need to be picked up at 6pm promptly from their normal exit point (outside of the Y6 classrooms). Please note, your child will not be allowed to walk home alone due to the time of the event.
