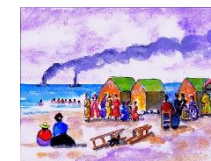

There will be an opportunity to share the most interesting fact you have found during your first week of Year 5!

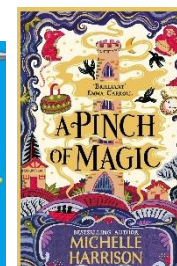
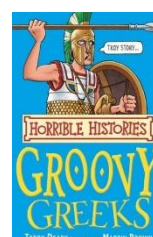
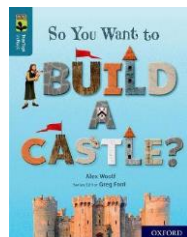
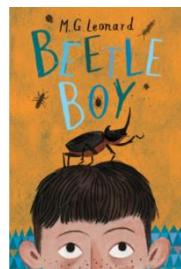
Summer Reading Challenge
