Our children new to Early Years...

We are incredibly proud of all children who have started their learning journey in our Early Years Provision. They are coming into school with more and more confidence and independence. Children are finding their own coat pegs, identifying their names and learning how to put things away in the correct places.

Staff are spending quality time with the children, on a 1-1 basis, getting to know them and their likes and dislikes. This will support staff in planning activities that reflect the children's interests. Reception staff are currently carrying out the Reception Baseline Assessment (a practical assessment of children's mathematics, communication and language and early Literacy skills). This data is then used to analyse children's progress from Reception to Year 6.
