**Challenge 1 Science- experiment time!**

Follow this simple recipe to make your own salt dough.  
Help your grown-up measure out the ingredients you need accurately and have fun mixing them together.  
Can you use some interesting describing words to talk to your grown-up about how it feels and what it looks like at each stage of the making process?

Once you have made your salt dough, try adding food colouring. How many drops do you need to make a pale colour? How many drops did you need to make a bright colour?

**How to make Salt Dough**

Mix together:

- \* 2 cups of plain flour
- \* 1 cup of salt
- \* Up to 1 cup of water

(add the water in slowly as you may need less)

**Knead the mixture into a dough and get creating**

(You can't really go wrong, if it's too sticky just add some more flour)

*A note for parents/carers*

**Read aloud**

As you watch the story with your child, allow time to pause and talk about what is happening in the story and the pictures. Encourage your child to think about how the character might be feeling and how they know (facial expression etc.)

**Join in**

When you return to the story, children might be able to have a conversation with you about parts of it, for example; What would their perfect pet be?

**Tell the story**

Once your child has heard the story a few times, they could tell the story to you using the pictures to guide them. Try and draw a story map together, your child should be familiar with these from their time in Reception.

**Challenge 3 Art/Design & Technology**

Create a poster about something you are really interested in or a hobby that you enjoy.



Use lots of colour or even collage materials to make it eye-catching. Include as much information as you can to make your poster really interesting.

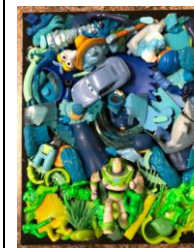
Challenge 7 Independence
