This could be completed using crayons, paint, oil pastels, black and grey pencil, collage etc. If you feel confident, you could use a combination of more than one!</p>	<p><u>The Reporter</u> Research what happened during The Great Fire of London. Write a report about The Great Fire of London. Include information such as dates, times and locations; how it affected London and what happened after the fire.</p>	<p><u>The Scientist</u> Record a healthy eating plate for yourself over 5 days. You are then going to compare your diet to the diet of a child in the 17th Century. What is the same? What is different? Would you lie to eat a diet from the 17th Century?</p>
<p><u>The Historian</u> Create a piece of work showing the development of the fire department in England from the 17th Century to now. This could be presented in a timeline or a leaflet.</p>		<p><u>The Emotion Coach</u> Think about how people were feeling during The Great Fire of London. Think about how they would have been affected during this time. Draw an outline of a person. On the inside, write down all the emotions that they would have been feeling. E.g. scared. On the outside, write down what they would have been doing. E.g. screaming.</p>
<p><u>The Geographer</u> Find or create a map of London. Using a coloured pencil, show the areas of London that were affected by the fire.</p>	<p><u>The Designer</u> Using materials of your choice, create a model of a Fire Engine. This can be done using materials such as card board, Lego, or another of your choice. Remember to plan, design, make and evaluate your work.</p>	<p><u>Comic creator</u> Create a comic strip showing the events of The Great Fire of London. Where possible, annotate parts of your comic explaining what it happening. Be as creative as possible with your comic!</p>
