The Tudors loved to make bread – Historians believed it was Henry VIII's favourite snack. Follow the link and make your own Tudor style bread.



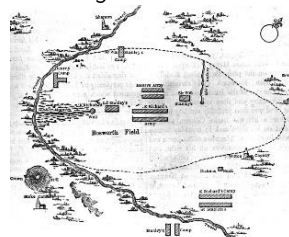
