World Space Week 2021

Perry Hall have celebrated World Space Week with each year group taking part in their own 'out of this world' lessons this week.

In Early Years, they have been reading 'Whatever Next' and looking at blasting off to the moon! Year 1 have looked at the first black woman to travel in to space - Mae Jemison - through the book 'Mae Among The Stars', before creating and launching their own version of her spacecraft 'Endeavour'. Year 2 focussed on the first British astronaut Helen Sharman and looked at what UFOs she may have seen. Year 4 discovered facts about Valentina Tereshkova, the first woman in space, before creating artworks celebrating her achievements.

Years 3, 5 and 6 focussed on the book 'Hidden Figures' (a true story where three female mathematicians help with the first moon landing), which they used as a prompt to think about their own inspirational women in their lives, create job advertisements for ESA and NASA, and to look at the gender inequality in space themed careers

respectively. Year 3 even launched their own class rockets using bicarbonate of soda and vinegar!

As you may have guessed from the list above, the theme this year is 'Women in Space' so we've had lots of fun learning about influential women as well as tackling gender stereotypes.



This week, we have been so impressed with how the children at Perry Hall have engaged with National Poetry Day. Year 1 wrote some fantastic poems about a fluffy, cuddly cat. Using The Story of Squiddly Diddly as inspiration, Year 2 drew some fantastic pictorial representations of the poem. Meanwhile in Year 3, the children performed some of their favourite poetry. Both Year 4 and Year 6 have

explored a poem about marine conservation and the importance of recycling. Through performance and discussions, they have investigated how human choice can affect nature. Finally, our Year 5 children were so inspired by the poem Which Wild One that they wrote poetry about their own creatures.
