### School Admissions

Deadline for online applications — 31st October 2021. If you do not apply by this date, your child may not be allocated a school.

The following details are for information of how to apply for Wolverhampton schools, excluding Thomas Telford or any private fee paying school.

If you are applying for a faith school (such as Our Lady & St Chad Catholic Academy, St Peter's Collegiate School, St Edmund's Catholic Academy, The King's C of E and The Royal School), the Supplementary Information Forms can be downloaded from the School Admissions website. They must be completed and returned directly to the school.

If you are applying for a school out of the Local Authority (e.g. Walsall) then please apply via their council website.

In addition to the online application, if you are applying to the following school's you are required to complete an additional Supplementary Information Form. **The form should be completed and returned direct to the school.**

### School Admissions

Having gathered as much information as possible please take time to think about your preference(s) before you apply online or complete the common application form (CAFI). Ask yourself the following questions:

- Does my child have an Educational Health Care Plan? (If the answer is 'yes', please do not complete this application process.).
- Do I know where the school is situated?
- Can my child (ren) get there without too much difficulty?
- Have I visited the school(s) to see for myself the facilities they have to offer?
- Have I obtained all the relevant forms/information for my preferred schools?
- Have I read and understood the procedures that will be used if there are more applicants than there are places available (i.e. the school is oversubscribed)?
- Do any of my preferred schools have a history of over-subscription? If so, how is my application likely to meet the criteria used for the allocation of places?
- Does everyone with parental responsibility for the child agree with (i) the preferred schools; and (ii) the order in which they are being presented?
- Do I need to seek clarification of any points before I submit my application? (i.e. common application form, supporting evidence form, entrance examination registration form etc.)
- What is the deadline for applying and Supporting Evidence forms?
