Dear Parents/Carers,

The children of Perry Hall have once again been called upon by the Mayor of Wolverhampton to compete to **design a Christmas card for the Mayor of Wolverhampton's official Christmas cards**. The mayor has requested that the **cards have a Wolverhampton theme**.

There are three categories in this competition: -

- children under 7 years
- children 7-11
- children aged 11 to 16 years

The 3 winning images will be featured on the official cards sent out by the Mayor this Christmas. **The winners, runners up and their families** will be invited to join **the Mayor for Christmas afternoon tea in the Mayor's Parlour** in December. The Mayor will also **visit the schools of the winners and runners up**, to congratulate the winners.

The designs can either be **A4 or A5** (half an A4 piece of paper) size but **must be the child's own original work**. The pictures can be portrait or landscape, but please **only use felt tip pens or paint** (as crayon, chalk, pastels, glitter and embellishments cannot be reproduced as cards). Please make sure **your child's full name, age and class are written clearly on the reverse of your child's Christmas card design** and send them in to school **no later than Monday 22nd November**.
