
Why Kingswood?

- Kingswood is a unique environment which uses the outdoors as a natural context for learning.
- A residential visit to Kingswood provides many children with their first independent experience away from their family.
- Allows children to experience skills and tasks which they wouldn't ordinarily get in school.
- Sharing and interacting with their peers in a new environment.

Itinerary - Day 1

A Place to Grow

- Leave school approx. 09:30 and arrive at Kingswood at 10:00am.
- Settling in, look around and then an activity 1.
- Lunch (picnic children bring with them a packed lunch)
- Activity 2 & 3
- Free time (supervised)
- Tea
- Free time (supervised)
- Trip down to the air raid shelter (optional)
- Hot chocolate and biscuits
- Approx. 21:00 Bed



Itinerary - Day 2

- Wake up approx. 07:30.
- Breakfast.
- Strip and remake the bed for the next group.
- Activity 4 & 5
- Hot dinner.
- Supervised free time.
- Return to school in time for normal home time.

- Den building
- Adventure ropes and tree climbing.

What will we be eating?

A Place to Grow

- Please ensure that you have completed the medical form and informed us of any dietary needs in advance of our visit.
- There is a vegetarian option available to all children.





Sleeping arrangements

- Children are allowed to bring a cuddly toy, family photo or anything else which they feel would make them more comfortable.
- Pupils will be sleeping in same gender dormitories containing between six and fourteen children. These groups will be selected by the teachers.
- Each dormitory will also have at least two adults.
- Pupils have easy access to toilets throughout the night and these will be pointed out to the pupils prior to them going to sleep.





Other information



- There is a small gift shop which will be open in the evening.
- If you would like your child to purchase anything please provide them with no more than £5 (preferably coins).
 Please provide this in a named and sealed envelope / container.
- We will only contact you in an emergency, but please make sure that you
 have provided us with up to date contact information and that you are able to
 receive a call if necessary.





Keeping in contact



- We will inform the school that all pupils have arrived safely at Kingswood and parents will then receive a text message.
- We will also call school when we are leaving and parents will be informed by text message.



Do's and do not's

Do's

- Please make sure that all clothing and personal belongings are named.
 These are your child's responsibility.
- Please send your child in comfortable and practical clothing and footwear.
 It is not a fashion show, they will be getting dirty!
- Please make sure you have given us up to date contact and medical information on the forms provided.
- Encourage your child that this is a safe and exciting time, so they really need to try and have a go at as many activities as they can!

Do not's

- Please don't 'overpack'. We are only away for two days and a night.
- Please don't send treats and midnight snacks. There is plenty of food provided.
- No electronic equipment such as mobiles, gaming equipment and cameras are allowed.
- DON'T WORRY AND ENJOY THE PEACE AND QUIET!



What happens next?




- The cost of the trip will be £78, which includes the transport to and from Kingswood. The cost of all other trips within Year 2 are kept to a minimal.
- A letter will go out on Friday 12th November asking for a deposit of £10 which will need to be paid by Friday 4th December in order to secure your child's place on the residential.
- The remaining amount is to be paid in full by **Friday 4**th **March**. (this can however be paid in instalments between the deposit being paid and the beginning of March).
- Dates children will be going are:

Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th June 2022 (numbers dependant- if interest is high, we will go in two groups and also attend 13th and 14th June 2022).

Please be assured that Kingswood have a full Covid risk assessment in place.


