
Covid Updates.



If your child displays any coronavirus symptoms, please ensure that they self-isolate and that you book them in for a PCR test (<u>https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test</u>) and not use a lateral flow device. Children's test results need to be continued to be emailed into the school email address.

If your child does test positive on a PCR test, the guidance regarding self-isolation periods has been updated. Please ensure that you have read this guidance fully: https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-stava-home-guidance-for-households-with-possible-coronavirus-covid-19-infection

*Your child should not take an LFD test before the sixth day of their isolation period, and they should only end their self-isolation after they have had 2 consecutive negative LFD tests which should be taken at least 24 hours apart. They should stop testing after they have had 2 consecutive negative test results.

All children over 5 identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 are strongly advised to take a LFD test every day for 7 days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they have a positive test result. Children under 5 are exempt from self-isolation and don't need to daily test.

Any pupil absences for 'any new ill health presentations', as well as those who become unwell whilst at school, are strongly encouraged to take a LFD test and not return to school unless the test returns a negative result and they feel well. If no LFD test is taken, the pupil will be able to return to the setting 48 hours after feeling well. This is recently updated guidance from Public Health.
