Covid Updates.

As the numbers of Covid-19 cases continue to rise within the local community, please use lateral flow device tests regularly

and arrange a PCR test if your child has Covid symptoms. As you will be aware, the self-isolation advice for people with coronavirus (COVID-19) has changed. It is now possible to end selfisolation after 5 full days if you have 2 negative LFD tests taken on consecutive days. The first LFD test should not be taken before the fifth day after your symptoms started (or the day your test was taken if you did not have symptoms). The self-isolation period remains 10 full days for those without negative results from 2 LFD tests taken a day apart. 
