Dear parent/carer,

On Wednesday 16th February, children in Year 6 have the opportunity to travel to St Matthews' Church in East Park to take part in the LIFE Exhibition. This visit is intended to enhance the children's Religious Education (RE) curriculum.

The LIFE Exhibition is an educational experience with active learning opportunities, matched to the RE curriculum. Using tablets, with text, graphics, DVD and sound, the exhibition is a 'hands on' interactive learning experience. LIFE tells of the life of Jesus, his teaching and miracles, and his death, burial and resurrection.

Children will be transported to St Matthews' Church via coach, they will leave school during the latter part of the morning and will arrive back to school towards the end of our lunch hour. Due to this, children will be eating and having their lunch break once the kitchen has closed, we therefore request that children bring a packed lunch with them on the day (containing no glass bottles or cans, preferably a water bottle instead). If your child is allocated free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided by the school's kitchen if requested.
