



Children's Mental Health Week 2022

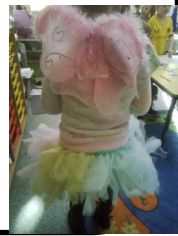
The children have had a fantastic week thinking about their emotional growth and ways to support each other to grow.

This week we celebrated Safer Internet Day with the theme "All fun and games?" during which we explored respect and relationships when online.

Safer Internet Day is celebrated globally in February each year to promote the safe and positive use of digital technology for children and young people, and to inspire a national conversation about using technology responsibly, respectfully, critically, and creatively.

Across school, a number of activities have been taking place to raise the profile of internet safety.

KS1 have been learning how to keep themselves safe online through the SMART rules as well as discussing information they should or should not share online.

KS2 have been developing their knowledge and understanding of personal identity. We have had year groups think about what information is posted online about their favourite celebrity, internet safety games created and have analysed online comments to suggest where issues may arise.

Please ensure that you supervise your child's online activity or make use of parent monitoring apps e.g. Live360, NetNanny, Kaspersky Safe Kids, MM Guardian, etc. Additionally, please spend time talking to your child about how their online actions could affect others.
