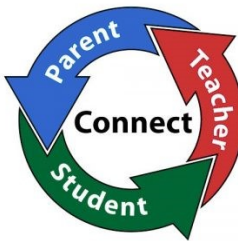


Parent Consultations

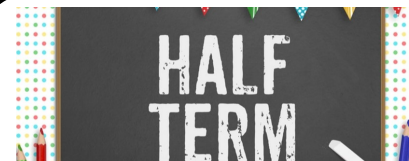
If you have received a structured meeting letter for your child, your child's class teacher will be arranging a date/time directly with you for this meeting to take place.
