Parent Consultations – 09.03.22

We are really looking forward to welcoming you into school tomorrow for your child’s parent consultation.

We are aware that it has been a long while since parents/carers have been in to the main school building and for some parents/carers, especially with younger children, it may be the first time entering the setting. With this in mind, we have produced a bird’s eye plan of school to outline where the parent consultations will be taking place. Year group staff will be based in one classroom, within their year group area, so that you are exposed to your child’s daily learning environment.

- All parents/carers of children in Year 6 will enter/exit school through at the front of school.
- Nursery parents/carers will enter via Nursery entrance.
- Two’s parents/carers will enter via the entrance.

We continue to be cautious with regards to COVID-19, therefore, please ensure that you do not attend your child’s parent consultation if you are displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 or are





feeling unwell. Hand gel will be available for use upon entry. The wearing of a face covering whilst inside the school building will be down to personal choice.

- Food/drink- protein bars, 3 in 1 coffee sachets, small packets of nuts/raisins, peanut butter in plastic jars, cupasoups
- Toiletries- toothbrushes, toothpaste, body wash, wet wipes, pocket tissues, shower gel, pampers, sanitary towels, tampons
- Medical- first aid kits, field bandages, paracetamol, ibuprofen, cold/flu treatment, antiseptic cream, bandages, sterile dressings, surgical tape, wound closure strips, multivitamins, Vicks vapour rub, barrier cream, cough syrup, antiseptic body wipes, hand gel.
