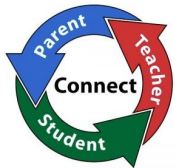

World Book Day Extravaganza 2022

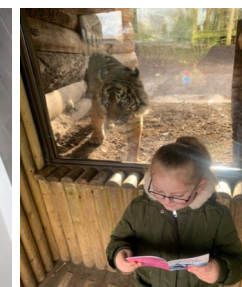
