- 05.05.22— Voting Day— School closed for Two's—Year 5 (more information to follow for year 6).



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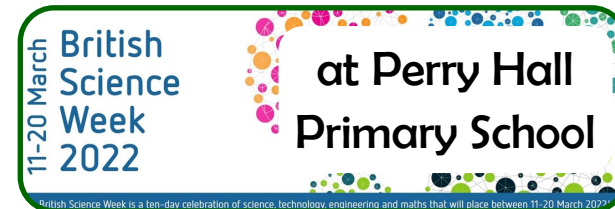
