A note for parents/carers

Read aloud

As you share the story with your child talk about what is happening and what they can see on the pictures. If you feel there are any words they may not understand do short vocabulary checks.

Discuss

Ask your child what their favourite part of the story was and why.

Retell the story/Creative writing

Once your child has heard the story a few times and drawn their story map, challenge them to think of an alternative ending to the story using their imagination. They can either tell you their story verbally or write it down.
