



Dear parents/carers,

We are very excited to inform you that on **Thursday 26th May** we will be celebrating **the Queen's Platinum Jubilee** throughout school. We ask that the children come to school wearing red, white or blue or a combination of these on the day.



During the morning, in all year groups from Reception to Year 6, will be learning about the Queen's life during one of the 7 decades she has reigned, before having the opportunity to take part in a **playground street party** at lunchtime. **Picnic food will be provided from the school kitchen**, if your child is eligible for school dinners or you have chosen to pay for them, **or children can bring in their own sandwiches from home** to join the playground street party if you choose to do so. Thank you for submitting the Forms questionnaire to indicate your child's lunch preferences for this day- to confirm this, please complete the slip below. **No hot meals will be served on this day.**

After lunch, weather dependent, will see the return of our **GlastonPerry festival**, this time revamped as A Royal Gala and will see our children perform songs from each of the decades of the Queen's reign:

Come join the children of Perry Hall Primary School as we celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. GlastonPerry: A Royal Gala will showcase music from the 50s up to the present day with each year group performing a song from a different decade.

Bring your picnic blanket to set up on the field for an afternoon of music and celebration.

As you can see above, families are welcome to join and listen to the performances (this will be at a distance with families spaced around the school field). **We invite you to bring a picnic blanket to set up on the school field to watch and enjoy.** Please only bring alcohol free refreshments and take any bottles/cans/litter home with you after. Families will be able to enter school from 1.15pm via the main gate.

We ask that you provide consent for your child to take part in this experience via the slip below, indicating that you **allow for your child to be photographed.** Unfortunately, **if we do not have permission of all parents/carers for photographs then we will not allow any to be taken.**

While we are confident that the event will go ahead as planned, we are at the mercy of the Great British weather. We will be closely monitoring the weather and if necessary, we will postpone the GlastonPerry festival until further notice, the other jubilee celebrations will still take place in school. A text message will go out before the day, confirming our intentions.

Children have been working hard on their own piece of **jubilee artwork** this half term. These will be on display for you to see during our GlastonPerry event. However, you also have the opportunity to **purchase their work, framed, to commemorate this once in a lifetime event.** Should you wish to do so, please **make a donation of £3 via ParentPay by Friday 20th May,** for your child's work to be sent home on Friday 27th May.
