Residential Visit to Kingswood Trust – Additional information for Parents/Guardians

We are very excited for the upcoming Year 2 residential to Kingswood Trust on Monday 6th June and Tuesday 7th June. Just a quick reminder of kit requirements and information that may be supportive to you.

Please do not over pack.

The suggested kit list for an overnight visit is as follows:

Night clothes

Toilet bag containing – toothbrush, toothpaste, flannel, soap, brush or comb and a towel.

Indoor shoes or slippers

Trainers or suitable outdoor shoes

Wellies (in a carrier bag)

Waterproof coat

Long sleeved top and T shirt

Long trousers/jog pants

Change of clothes (including underwear and extra socks for winter)

Hat, gloves and scarf (winter) Sunhat and sunscreen (summer)

Soft toy for bed

2 named plastic carrier bags

A water bottle (empty to avoid spillage on the journey here)

NB: Please ensure all belongings are clearly named.

Children are to come into school through the main gate, as normal, on Monday 6th June and will be supported by staff in taking their bags into the Junior Hall. They will then travel to Kingswood Trust on the school minibuses at around 9.30am.

Children will be participating in a number of activities during the two days. These include: orienteering, pond dipping, a walk around the local area, an air raid shelter experience and animal handling.

We know that this is going to be a completely new experience for many of our children. You will receive a text when children arrive on the day, during the evening to inform you how they are getting on, how their night went and when they return to school on the Tuesday.
