

Portrait Competition to Celebrate the Platinum Jubilee

The City of Wolverhampton Council has launched a contest as part of the city's Platinum Jubilee celebrations marking 70 years since Her Majesty became the monarch. Budding Wolverhampton artists are required to create a portrait of the queen, with the chance to have their work displayed in the city's art gallery. Portraits can be drawn, painted or even created digitally – the only criteria is that they must feature the Queen, be the entrant's own work, the entrant must live in Wolverhampton and portraits must be no bigger than A3 in size.

There are four categories: children under 7 years, children aged 7 to 11, children aged 12 to 18 years and adults.

Entries need to be submitted by 4pm on Friday May 31. They will be judged by a panel including the Mayor of Wolverhampton, local radio personality Dicky Dodd and representatives from the West Midlands Lieutenancy, the city's youth council and a local artist.

The winners will see their work given pride of place on display in an exhibition at Wolverhampton Art Gallery. They will also get to have afternoon tea with the Mayor and win a goody bag of jubilee-themed gifts.

This competition is open to everyone, whatever your ability level, we want you to get creative, use your imagination and send us your best portrait of the Queen.

Entrants must include their full name, age and postal address as well as either a phone number or email address with their submission. 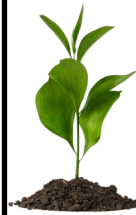


A Place to Grow
